

ALBION HILLS LEADERSHIP CAMP!

WHAT? S.C.I. is running a leadership camp weekend for grade 9 students.

WHO? All grade 9 students are eligible to attend, but the facility accommodates 48 campers, so space is limited. Teacher recommendations will be considered in selecting students, but a teacher recommendation is not required. Grade 11/12 student leaders will accompany the grade 9's. They will organize and run the activities.

WHEN / WHERE?

This year's camp is from Friday May 5th to Sunday May 7th.

Albion Hills is a Toronto District School Board Outdoor Education facility, located northwest of Bolton, less than an hour from Toronto.

Albion Hills is large property offering a variety of indoor and outdoor activities. It is fully-equipped facility with a large common room, separate boys and girls sleeping quarters, as well as a spacious kitchen/dining hall. The kitchen will accommodate students with special dietary needs.

WHY? Participants take part in a variety of fun, team-building and co-operative tasks that develop confidence, improve problem-solving and communication skills and create and/or strengthen friendships.

COST? \$125.00. This includes transportation, meals, snacks, activities and accommodations.

NOTE: Some activities are conducted outdoors. Students should bring warm clothing (jackets, hats, gloves boots) Albion Hills can provide rain jackets, rubber, boots gloves and hats for students who need them.
