GENERAL EXAMINATION PROCEDURES FOR STUDENTS

1. It is the student's responsibility to be in the right place at the right time for each examination. Students who are late for an examination will be allowed to write for the balance of time remaining only. All students must remain in their seats for the duration of the exam.
2. Prior to entering the exam room, students must leave all coats, books, notes, etc. in their lockers or at the front of the examination room.
3. Students should be in their room at least 10 minutes before the start of the exam.
****Remember to bring TEXTS to be handed in. ****
4. *No electronic devices including cell phones, MP3's, I-pod, programmable calculators, etc. are allowed.*
5. It is the student's responsibility to provide his/her own pens, pencils, erasers, mathematical instruments and any other equipment required by the course teacher.
6. Students are to make sure that their name is on every sheet of their examination paper.
7. Copying, showing intent to copy or being in possession of unauthorized materials in the examination room will result in the cancellation of the entire paper.
8. Students who are absent from an examination and who do not bring a doctor's note covering the absence will receive a mark of zero (0) for the examination.
All doctor notes are due in the main office by noon Tuesday, February 2, 2016.
